The following lists the parking options for residents when rotating at ZSFG.

IF TRAVELING BY CAR

Monthly Parking Pass - Campus Parking

- Monthly parking passes are available for the 23rd Street Parking Garage.
- The passes are for the first of the month through the end of the month, there is no pro rated parking.
- Resident roster is submitted to the parking management quarterly by the ZSFG Dean's Office. If your name is not on the roster, contact the ZSFG residency site coordinator.
- Residents should call LAZ parking at 415-517-4425, prior to stopping by to determine if the passes are located at 23rd street Kiosk in the garage or the office at 24th street.
- The cost is \$190 per month, as of July 1, 2022.

7-Day Pass – Parking Campus

- 7-day passes for the campus are available at the window in the parking garage.
- The parking pass can begin on any day of the week but is for 7 consecutive days.
- The cost is \$95.

On-Call Parking - Parking Garage (see pg. 2 for more details)

- Parking is available on an as needed basis when called back there are only 46 slots available.
- Garage swipe cards are available from your department and subject to department procedures.
- The use of these passes is closely monitored and audited monthly by the ZSFG Dean's Office.

Day Parking – Parking Garage

• Cost is \$5.00 for the first hour, and \$3 an hour thereafter. The daily maximum \$29.00 per day (12:00 AM – 11:59 PM)

Street Parking

- Please beware of the neighborhood zone requirement and/or street cleaning days.
- You can be escorted to your car 5 PM to 7 AM (7 days a week) by contacting the institutional
 police at 206-8063. (There may be times when there are delays due to on-going incidents and
 staff breaks). Escort service is limited to a 4 block radius and/or the 24th street & Mission BART
 station.
- When providing "reverse escorts" from the parking garage, the sheriffs will only pick up from the pay booth of the garage.

IF TRAVELING BY MOTORCYCLE

Monthly garage parking permits are \$90. You can get the permits at the garage.

IF TRAVELING BY BICYCLE

There are bike lockers and bike stalls located at various locations on campus. Access can be
obtained by contacting residency site coordinator. The new bike cage can only be accessed by
ZSFG ID Badges.

IF USING MASS TRANSIT

- UC Shuttle from 16th Street Bart via the Yellow Line, from Parnassus via the Blue Line; from Mission Bay via the Gold Line.
- 24th Street Bart is a 15-minute walk or you can take MUNI (the 48) from 23rd Street across from the garage.

ON CALL PARKING

On-call parking cards are available for use when taking call at ZSFG. On-call parking is not free parking and it is to be used only while on-call. per your departmental guidelines. Each ZSFG department manages the physical garage cards and the ZSFG Dean's Office audits your usage every month. If you misuse the system you will lose your On-Call parking privileges.

Only residents rotating on ZSFG Plastic Surgery, ZSFG Vascular Surgery or ZSFG Trauma/General Surgery use the ZSFG Trauma/General Surgery parking cards.

ZSFG Critical Care, ZSFG NeuroSurgery, ZSFG Neuro Critical Care, ZSFG Oral Maxillofacial Surgery, ZSFG Ortho have separate parking cards available for use. Contact the site coordinator.

ZSFG Trauma/ General Surgery On-Call Parking Card Policy (Effective July 1, 2022)

- All medical students, interns, residents, and fellows must provide a \$40 check/ money order deposit before they can sign out a parking card. No parking cards will be given to trainees who do not have a check/ money order on file. No exceptions.
- All parking cards must be returned to Hugh Swarts in the ZSFG Surgery Office (Ward 3A) in person and may no longer be passed on to another trainee. Trainees are responsible for the parking card until it is signed in by Hugh.
- All parking cards not returned within three (3) days of the last rotation at ZSFG will have their check cashed to replace the card. Repeated failure to return parking cards within the 3 day window will result in losing on-call parking card privileges.
- Trainees are responsible for all lost, stolen, or misplaced cards. Repeatedly losing parking cards will result in losing on-call parking card privileges.
- There are 46 slots allotted to on-call residents in the ZSFG garage, per the agreement between the city and the resident union.
- There are a total of 200 cards in circulation.
- If a resident in the 47th person at the garage their card will not work until a resident comes out (card will read void).
- If a resident pulls a ticket for the garage they must pay for it, they will not be reimbursed by ZSFG or the ZSFG Dean's Office.
- If a resident pulls a ticket to enter the garage, they cannot exit with a swipe card, they will be expected to pay for the ticket.
- Residents need to exit with the same card they entered with. Do not trade cards while on-call in the hospital.
- If a resident believes they were not the 47th person in, I need the date, time, and card number before I can determine if it is a tech issue or not.
- Residents caught abusing the system, ie using the card when they are not on-call, will lose their ZSFG on-call parking privileges.
- If an on-call parking card is lost there is a \$40 replacement fee.
- Replacement fees must be paid by check written to "SFMTA-ZSFG Garage" and delivered to our office.

Please use the cards wisely.

The ZSFG Dean's Office audits card usage.

Abuse of the system may result in the city cancelling the program for all residents.
